Appendix D

(Not all schools will receive all rosters)

1. **Active List (MA1001AB):** Students newly selected this year (B status) by a random computer process according to priorities listed in the CHOICES brochure, and continuing students (A status). This includes students originally on the Wait List that have been accepted.

**Note: Students who appear on your "Students Without Applications" list included in this packet will NOT appear on your Active List. This will throw off your numbers. You must contact Rocio Estrella at the Magnet Office at (213) 241-6532 ASAP to rectify the situation.**

2. **Wait List (MA1001W):** Eligible students who were not selected, but whose applications were received in the Integration Office by the application deadline (December 18, 2009). These students (W status) are listed in random selection order based on the number of priority points.
3. **Late Applicants (MA1001Z):** Students whose applications were received after the application deadline, and by the late application deadline (January 29, 2010).
4. **Alpha Wait (MA1001WC):** This is another version of your wait list roster. It is in alphabetical order. This order does not represent the order in which you will call students; it is meant as a reference to more quickly find a student.
5. **Magnet-to-Magnet Student Changes (MA1005):** Students no longer on your Active List (MA1001AB) roster who have applied to and been selected at another Magnet. (This is NOT considered a Magnet-to-Magnet transfer.)
6. **Ethnic Summary (MA2003):** A list of all currently enrolled newly accepted students broken down by grade level and ethnicity. *Students who appear on your "Students Without Applications" list will not be included in the Ethnic Summary.*
7. **No Match List (MA1001X):** This list shows students whose needs cannot be met at the Magnet school to which they applied. However, if the student is exited from Special Education, please contact the Magnet Program Specialist for further direction. (See Page SPED-1 in the Magnet Handbook for further explanation of the Special Ed. selection process).
8. **Not Verified for Gifted/High Ability List (MA1001N):** This list is for gifted/high ability Magnets only. This is a list of students who applied to your Magnet but were either not verified or their school did not return the verification form. You may call the Magnet office to determine which category a child falls into. Keep this list of students in mind if you are accepting walk-in applications.
9. **Pending Special Education List (MA1001P):** This list shows students who have been selected for your Magnet but have an IEP. The Special Education Support Unit will determine whether their needs can be met at your school or not. These students' spaces have been held as part of your accepted students. Please call Sara after April 5, 2010 to determine whether they are accepted (B status) or not a match (X status).
10. **Students Enrolled Without a Choices Application On File (Selected Schools Only):** This list includes students who were enrolled at your school without filing a Choices application. You must contact Rocio Estrella in the Magnet Office at (213) 241-6532 to rectify the situation. *See above note in box for additional important information.*
11. **Out of District Student List:** Students whose name appears on this list have an out-of-District address in SIS. The Magnet program is for students who reside within the boundaries of LAUSD only. If this address is incorrect, please verify residency and make the corrections in the system. Otherwise, this child must leave your Magnet at the end of this school year.
